

Installing i-CATVision and Importing Studies from a CD

Step 1

If you already have i-CATVision installed on your computer you may skip to Step 2B.

Step 2A

Insert the CD into the CD drive. It will AutoRun and you should see the following dialogue box:



(If the CD does not AutoRun – navigate to **This PC** and double-click the CD drive. If it still does not AutoRun – **right-click** (with the **right** mouse button) the CD drive and select **Open**. Then **right-click** the file **Vision.exe** and select **Run as administrator**).


Click **Run Runthis.exe** and you will see the following Licencing Terms:



Click **ACCEPT** to continue.

Step 3A


You will see the following dialogue box:



Click Yes to install a copy of i-CATVision on your computer.

Step 4A


You will see a "Browse For Folder" dialogue box. Navigate to the folder **C:\Program Files (x86)\ISIP\iCATVision** if not already highlighted.



Click **OK** to continue.

Step 5A


You will see a dialogue box similar to the following:



Click **Yes** to continue.

Step 6A


You will see the following dialogue box:



Click **Yes** to store a copy of the patient data on your computer.

Step 7A

You will see this dialogue box while the images are being imported:




After a short time, i-CATVision will open and you will see your Patient in the Study List. Click on the **Patient Name** and then click on the **Study** to view your images.

If you already have i-CATVision installed on your computer:


Step 2B

Insert the CD into the CD drive but **DO NOT LET IT AUTORUN:**




Step 3B

Launch i-CATVision and select **Tools->Import Study:**




Step 4B

Step 5B


Click the **Browse** button and navigate to the folder on the CD:



Click **OK** to continue.


Step 6B
